

## LEARNING NAMES OF NOTES ON LINES BASS CLEF

The names of the notes on lines, named from the bottom to the top of the staff, are G - B - D - F - A.

To help remember the names, think of this sentence:  
**Good Boys Deserve Fudge Always**

G      B      D      F      A

## READING NOTES THAT MOVE BY STEPS BASS CLEF

Notes in the bass clef also use the letters A - B - C - D - E - F - G.  
The letters live in different places in the bass clef.

When notes go **up** the steps, their names go **forward**.

G    A    B    C    D    E    F    G    A

When notes come **down** the steps, their letter names go **backwards**.

A    G    F    E    D    C    B    A    G

**Remember**--the notes in **spaces** use the letters A-C-E-G.
