Celebration Chimes

DT-5001-ECR \$12.00

An ideal first piece that enables a beginning group to sound impressive. Quarter notes and whole notes help establish a good ringing stroke. Full chords give new ringers confidence.

Invocation

DT-5003-ECR \$24.00

Easy independent rhythms between treble clef and bass clef expand the new choir's skills. A beginning group could play this for an introit after a few rehearsals.

March Triumphant

DT-5004-ECR \$24.00

A ceremonial march tempo makes this an excellent piece for new ringers. A running bass line offers a pleasant contrast to full chords. The key of Bb major gives some ringers a chance to use their black notes.

Angelic Chorus

DT-5002-ECR \$24.00

Easy patterns of whole, half and quarter notes in the same patterns for all ringers help establish a feel for rhythmic relationships. Contrasts in dynamics, texture, and range add interest and an opportunity to explore musical concepts.

Meteors and Full Moon (2 separate pieces)

DT-5005-ECR \$28.00

Suggesting bursts of shooting stars, *Meteors* is a good introduction to contrasting rhythms. *Full Moon* is an easy chordal piece in 3/4 meter. Either title can be used alone or together as a short suite. Compatible with the same title DT-1010.

Oriental Breeze

DT-5006-ECR \$24.00

Lower bells have the melody in the middle section of this composition in C-minor. Chimes enhance the oriental flavor of this mostly chordal piece. Compatible with the same title DT-1011.
